## III. **Financials** - Devin (see Treasurer's Report for full details)

- A. October contributions were significantly more than September (\$9,000+)
- B. Total contributions are over total \$14,000 ahead of last year; still under budget
- C. Operational expenses are just under budget, but still ahead of last year by \$5,000
- D. Operating cash is just under \$21,000
- E. Prudent reserve is \$49,597, with a goal of \$60,000
- F. Deficit is \$800.19, down almost \$12,000 from last month (improvement)
- IV. **2024 budget** Bill C.
  - A. Finance committee worked on 2024 budget, was Board-approved tonight
    - i. Presented to reps to take back to their groups in hopes for December approval
    - ii. Narrative
      - 1. Current staff model used (PT office manager + 2 PT staff members)
      - 2. Total revenue is budgeted up 7% from 2022 at \$136,000 for 2024
      - 3. Sales are budgeted even with 2022 and 2023
      - 4. Contributions budgeted at \$96,000, just slightly more than 2022
      - 5. Expenses budgeted at \$141,000, 15% over 2022
        - a. Anticipate having full office staff for full calendar year
        - b. Reductions made in recurring expenses (Comcast, AT&T, copier)
        - c. Did not budget for any add'l office equipment purchases
        - d. \$2,500 misc. expense in place if needed
        - e. \$5,319 deficit forecasted, might break even
        - f. Outreach expenses include Lifeline and events
        - g. Recommend adding budget item to send office manager to annual Intergroup office seminar
          - i. Good way to network and interact with other office manager
        - h. Propose that as an unresolved item in the 2024 budget and include in 2025 budget
        - i. Mary motioned to Board-approve the 2024 budget
          - i. 2nd by Frank
          - ii. Unanimous motion carried to Board-approve the 2024 budget
