 - 2. We've been able to cut expenses, which are currently lower this year than last
 - 3. We have funds in the checking account
 - 4. Prudent reserve can be tapped into for large issues if needed
- C. Prudent reserve is \$49,316, with goal of \$60,000

 - i. In layman's terms:
 - 1. 2023 budget estimated we would lose about \$17,000 over the course of 2024, which would shrink our bank account
 - 2. Instead, we have \$21,000 at the close of November in checking account
 - 3. Actual numbers are compared to budget to make sure we're on track, don't have any extraordinary expenses, and that we're setting enough aside for the prudent reserve
